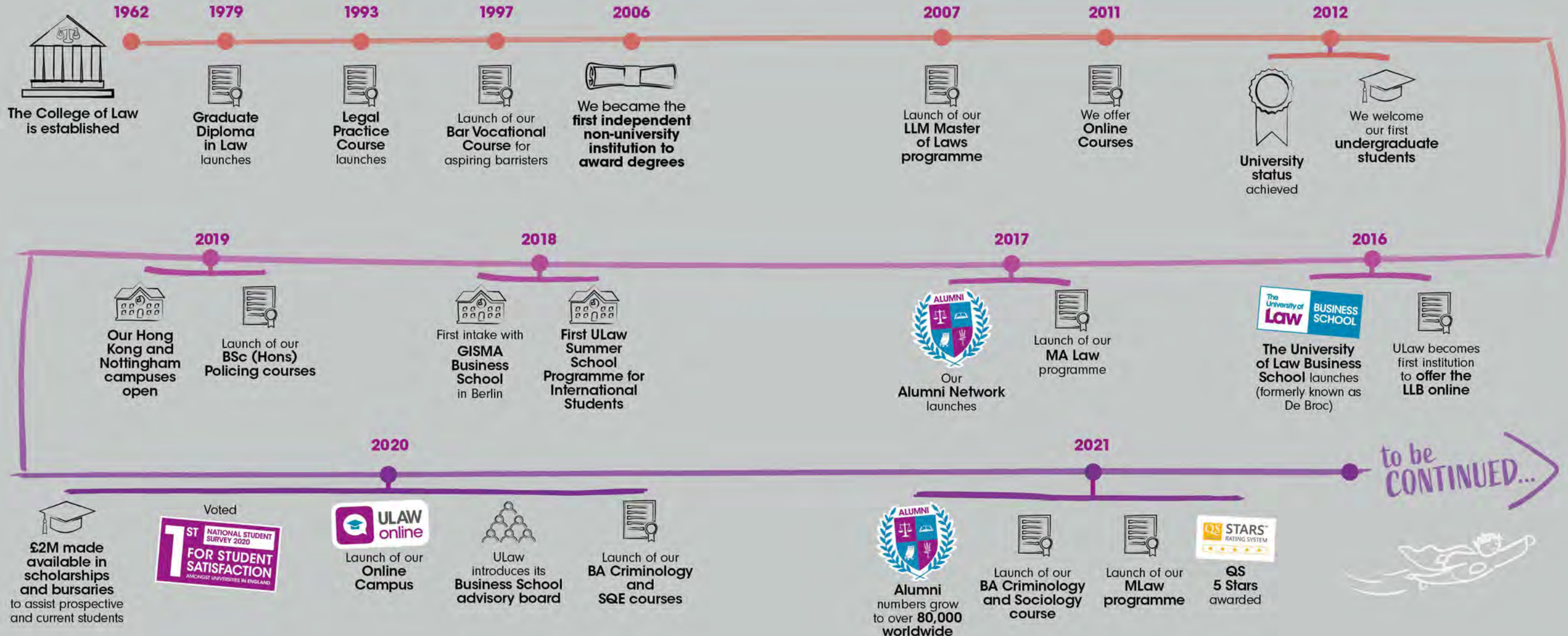

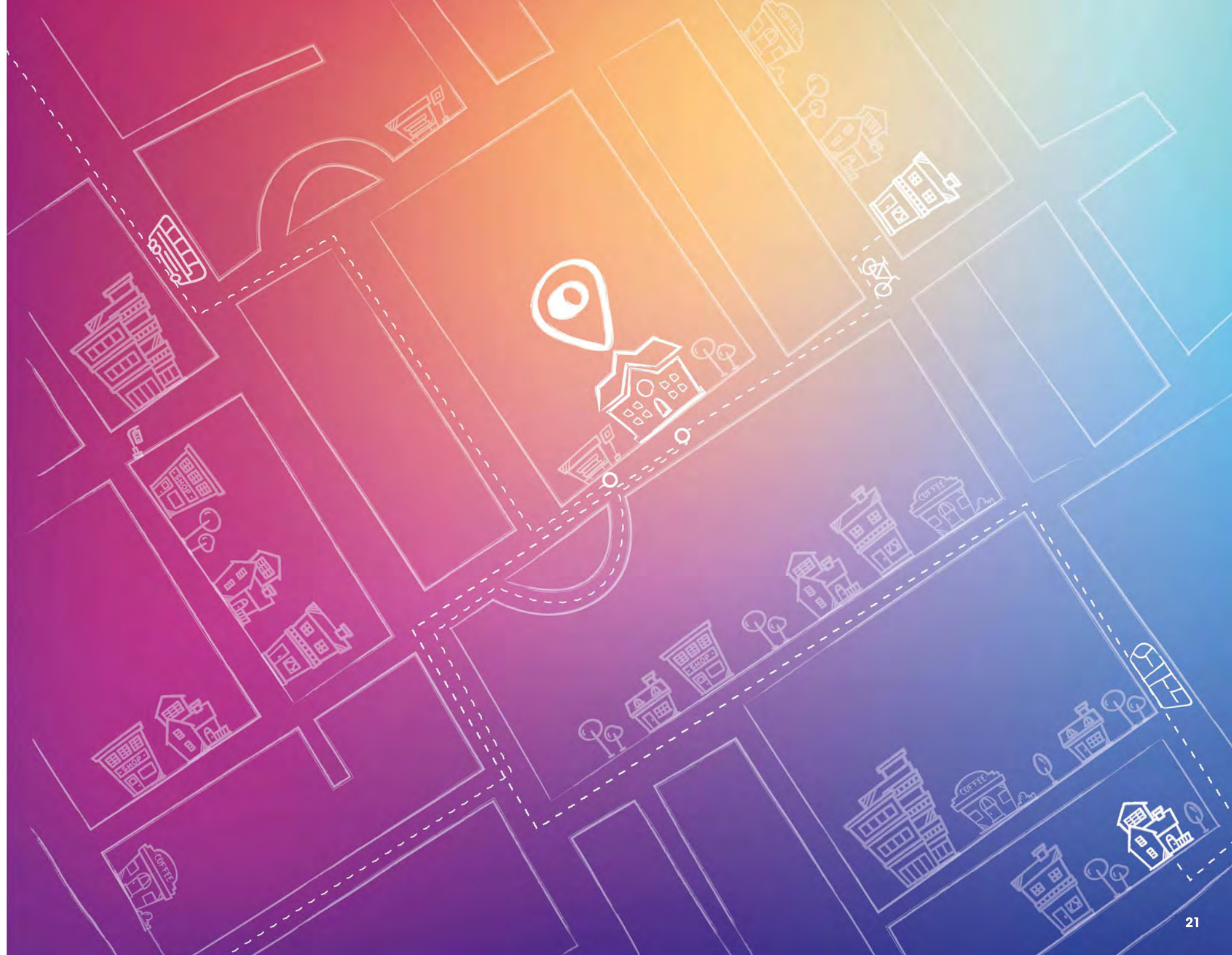

Our courses have been designed by practising criminologists with extensive experience in both academic and practical aspects of the study of crime, the causes of crime and the control and management of crime. BA Criminology and Policing take a critical criminology approach to the phenomena of crime and social harms in wider society. They cover a wider range of key contemporary and current issues and equip students to both critically examine these phenomena from theoretical, empirical and practical perspectives and approaches.

RELEVANT TEACHING

Students will develop an understanding of criminological and sociological concepts and theories, and will use these to critically engage with a range of current issues. These include race, ethnicity and crime, gender and crime, the media and crime, globalization and crime and key manifestations of crime such as illegal drug use, cybercrime, migration, environmental crime, social harms, mass incarceration, terrorism, trafficking, marginalisation and criminalisation.

Our courses include cutting edge criminological theories such as Green Criminology, Queer Criminology and Critical Race Theory. We consider contemporary issues and events, such as the Black Lives Matter movement.

LEADING COURSE STRUCTURE

You will learn through a variety of group sessions, workshops and digital media resources before completing a dissertation in your final year. Our degrees benefit from both a theoretical and vocational background, meaning you can obtain a wide variety of analytical, research and problem-solving skills, which we believe are highly valued by employers.

The transferable skills students acquire can serve as a sound foundation for a specialist master's degree in related areas of policing, criminology, criminal justice, security and many more.

ULaw also offers access to the BSc Professional Policing as a two year accelerated programme, helping you reach your career goals sooner. ACCREDITED PATHWAYS TO POLICING

The BSc Professional Policing course has been designed to meet the requirements of the College of Policing National Curriculum for the role of a Police Constable under the National Policing Education Qualifications Framework.

Application and recruitment to a police force are separate and independent from the study on the degree and students need to make sure that they meet all of the recruitment criteria for the police service if they want to use their degree to join.

PRACTICAL SUPPORTIVE TEACHING

You will learn in a safe and supportive environment and be provided with a blend of learning activities and practical tasks. Our tutors are experts in policing and have relevant practical experience. You will also hear from regular guest speakers. We have modern **Crime Scene Suites** allowing a practical approach to policing along with our **Virtual Reality Scenarios** to ensure the most realistic experience for your career*.

WHY CHOOSE ULAW FOR POLICING?

The PEQF (Police Education Qualification Framework) is a new professional framework for the education of police officers and staff. Under the PEQF there are three ways to enter a police force as a constable. This degree, the Pre-join degree in Professional Policing, is one of those three entry routes.

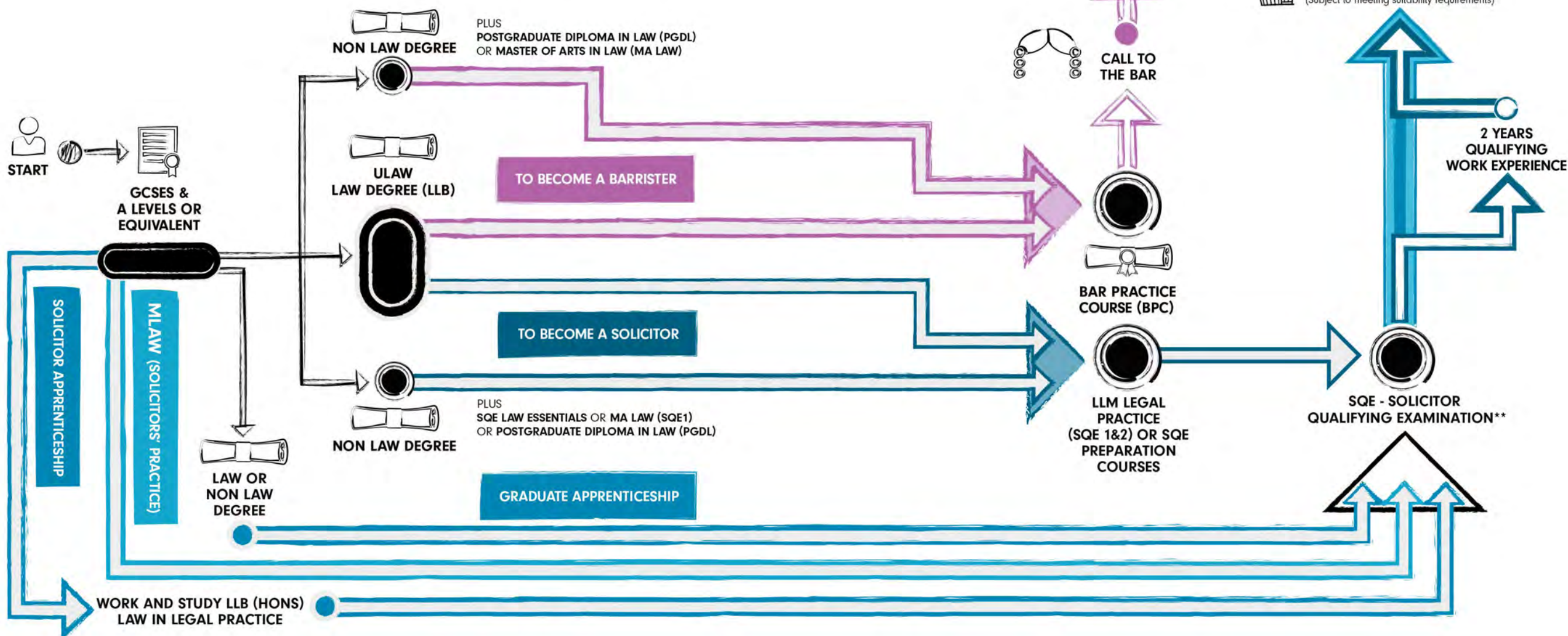

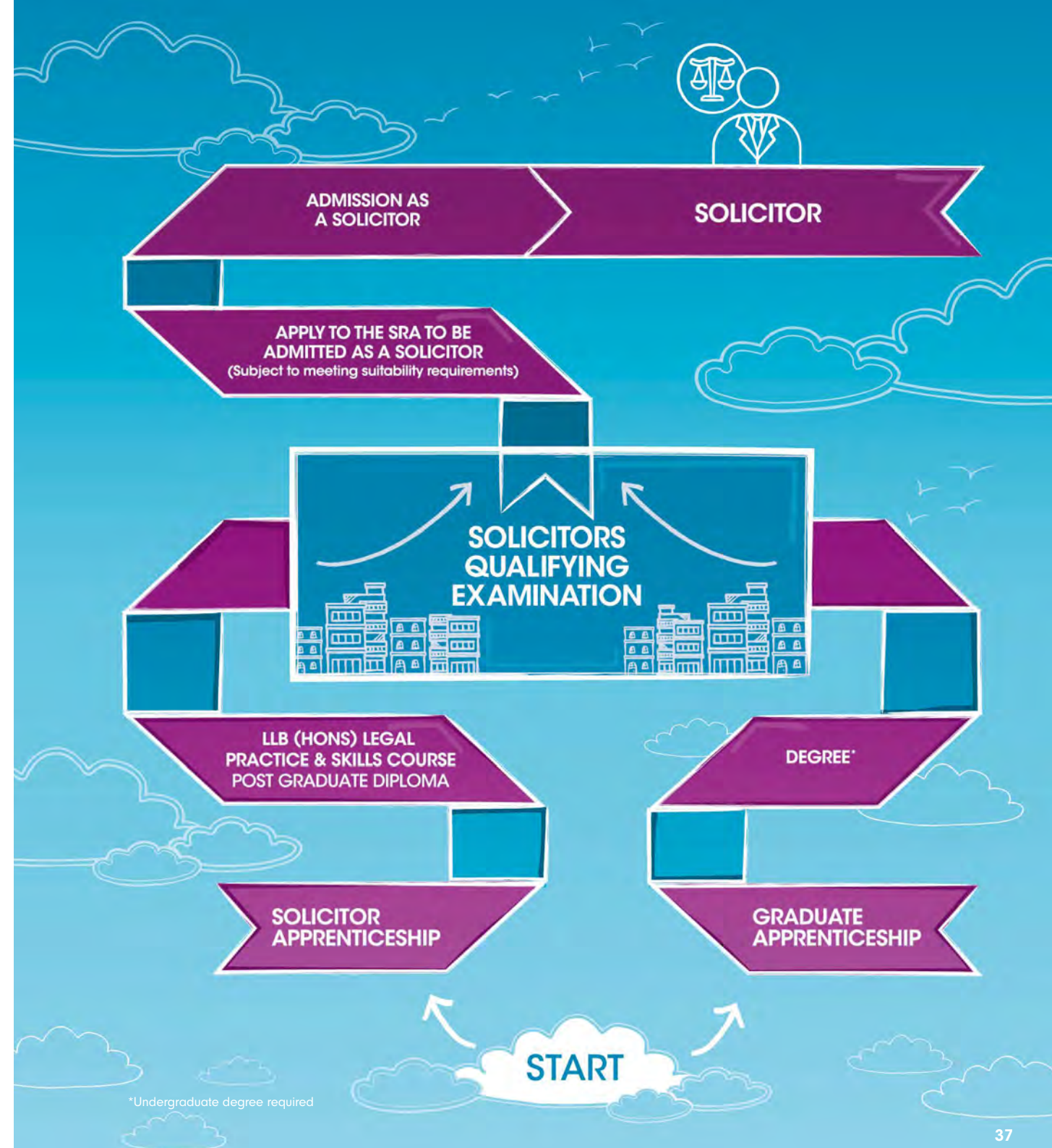

We understand that every mind is different and learning takes on many forms for each individual. Our support service and our team of tutors are here to ensure you are fully supported to maintain your academic performance.

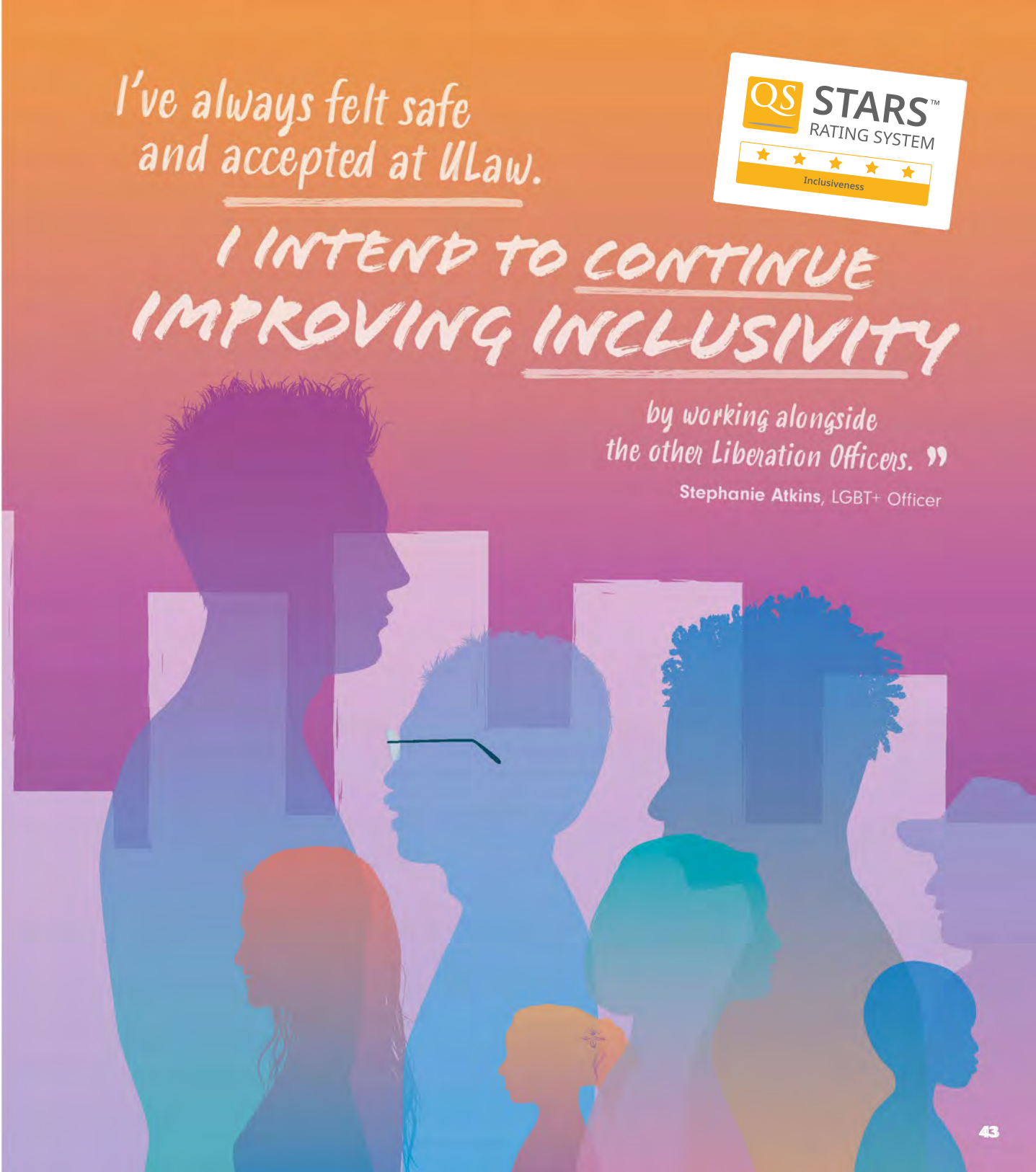

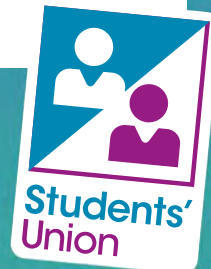
STUDENTS' UNION



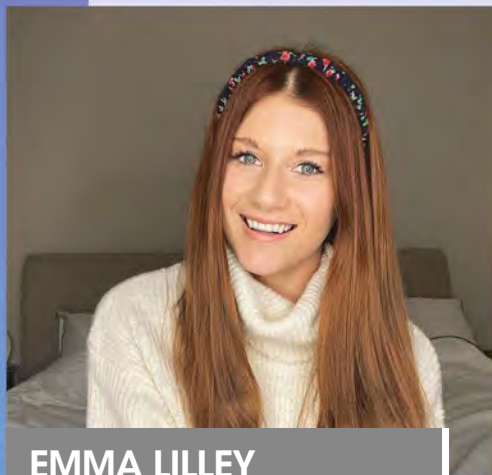
